1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO MAKE A
3	NOTATION ON A NORTH CAROLINA DRIVERS LICENSE SHOWING A LICENSE
4	HOLDER'S MILITARY SERVICE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 20-7(q) reads as rewritten:
7	"(q) Active Duty Military Designation. – The Division shall develop a military
8	designation for drivers licenses that may, upon request, be granted to North Carolina residents
9	on active duty and to their spouses and dependent children. A drivers license with a military
10	designation on it may be renewed by mail no more than two times during the license holder's
11	lifetime. A license renewed by mail under this subsection is a permanent license and does not
12	expire when the license holder returns to the State. A drivers license with a military designation
13	on it issued to a person on active duty may be renewed up to one year prior to its expiration
14	upon presentation of military or Department of Defense credentials."
15	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
16	subsection to read:
17	"(q1) <u>Veteran Military Designation. – The Division shall develop a military designation</u>
18	for drivers licenses that may, upon request, be granted to North Carolina residents who are
19	honorably discharged from military service in the United States Armed Forces. The designation
20	shall show the branch of military service in which the applicant served. An applicant requesting
21	this designation must produce a Form DD-214 showing the applicant has been honorably
22	discharged from the United States Armed Forces."
23 24	<b>SECTION 3.</b> There is appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Division of Motor Vahialas of the Department of Transportation the sum of seventeen thousand nine
24 25	Motor Vehicles of the Department of Transportation the sum of seventeen thousand nine hundred forty dollars (\$17,940) for fiscal year 2010-2011 to implement the provisions of this

20 27	act. <b>SECTION 4.</b> Section 3 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2010. Sections 1 and
28	2 of this act become effective when the Division of Motor Vehicles has completed the
28 29	implementation of the Division's Next Generation Secure Driver License System or July 1,
30	2012, whichever occurs first, and applies to drivers licenses issued on or after that date.
