Short Title: Mayor of Ahoskie Term of Office. (Local) Sponsors: Representatives Mobley; Spear and Wray. Referred to: Local Government II, if favorable, Judiciary I. February 23, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE MAYOR OF AHOSKIE FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The Charter of the Town of Ahoskie, being Chapter 609 of the 1963 Session Laws, as amended under G.S. 160A-101 to make the Mayor elected for a two-year term by the qualified voters, is amended by adding a new section to read: "Sec. 4.3A. Elections of Mayor. The Mayor shall be elected for a four-year term in 2011 and quadrennially thereafter by all the qualified voters of the town." SECTION 2. This act does not affect the term of office of the Mayor elected in 2009.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 2011.
