A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ACQUIRE REAL PROPERTY THAT WILL ASSIST IN ACCOMMODATING CAMPUS EXPANSION AND GROWTH AT FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY RELATED TO BRAC.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year to be allocated to Fayetteville State University. The funds shall be used to acquire properties located in close proximity to the campus. Fayetteville State University needs the additional property to accommodate campus growth related to BRAC and as a location for the construction of new campus facilities.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
