shelter may apply for registration as a clinic under this Article to purchase, possess, and 1 2 administer sodium pentobarbital and other drugs approved for use in animal euthanasia. An 3 animal shelter that is registered under this section may apply for registration with the federal 4 Drug Enforcement Agency under the federal Controlled Substances Act, as administered by the Drug Enforcement Agency, as a licensee authorized to acquire, store, and dispense sodium 5 pentobarbital and other euthanasia drugs, subject to regulations of the Drug Enforcement 6 Agency. An animal shelter's acquisition of solutions containing sodium pentobarbital and other 7 8 approved euthanasia drugs shall be made by the shelter's chief operating officer or by a licensed 9 veterinarian." 10 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
