A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING COUNTIES TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO CHARTER SCHOOLS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 153A-149(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(c) Each county may levy property taxes for one or more of the purposes listed in this subsection up to a combined rate of one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) on the one hundred dollars (\$100.00) appraised value of property subject to taxation. Authorized purposes subject to the rate limitation are:	
<u> </u>	<u>Charter schools. – To provide funds to charter schools located within the</u> <u>county for the operations or capital expenses of the charter schools.</u> " ECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
