1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO ADOPT THE ALBEMARLE POTATO FESTIVAL AS THE OFFICIAL IRISH
3	POTATO FESTIVAL OF THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA.
4	Whereas, North Carolina's northeast region has been home of the Albemarle Potato
5	Festival, now known as the North Carolina Potato Festival, for over 24 years; and
6	Whereas, of the more than 17,000 acres statewide used for Irish potato cultivation,
7	the northeast region of the Albemarle contains 12,000 of those acres; and
8	Whereas, the economic impact of Irish potato farming is at least 13 to 16 million
9	dollars annually in the northeast region; and
10	Whereas, the festival showcases the Albemarle area's major Irish potato producing
11	counties, with Pasquotank County being the largest producer in the State; and
12	Whereas, the festival entertainment, street fair, water activities, and evening dance
13	draw attention throughout the northeast region; and
14	Whereas, the tourism industry flourishes during the North Carolina Potato Festival,
15	benefiting the economy of not only the northeast region but also the entire State; Now,
16	therefore,
17	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
18	SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
19	section to read:
20	" <u>§ 145-30. State potato festival.</u>
21	The Albemarle Potato Festival is adopted as the official Irish potato festival of the State of
22	North Carolina."
23	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
