HOUSE BILL 630

Short Title: Summary Ejectment/Trials. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE TRIAL IN A SUMMARY EJECTMENT PROCEEDING
MAY COMMENCE NOT SOONER THAN FORTY-EIGHT HOURS AFTER SERVICE
OF THE COMPLAINT AND SUMMONS ON THE DEFENDANT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 42 of the General Statutes is amended by adding
a new section to read as follows:

"§ 42-30.1. Time within which trial is set.

The time for trial of a summary ejectment proceeding under this Article shall be set not
sooner than 48 hours after service has been made on the defendant as provided in G.S. 42-29,
excluding weekends and legal holidays."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
