A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO STUDY
STRATEGIES FOR MAKING THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS FOR COMMUNITY
COLLEGE FACILITIES MORE EFFICIENT.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** The State Board of Community Colleges shall review the 7 construction process for community college facilities and shall study strategies for making the 8 process more efficient. In the course of the study the Board shall consider: 9 (1) The capacity of the various colleges to construct capital facilities without

- (1) The capacity of the various colleges to construct capital facilities without oversight by the Office of State Construction;
- 11 (2) The appropriateness of increasing the cost threshold at which oversight by 12 the Office of State Construction is required for some or all of the colleges; 13 and
- 14(3)The need for oversight by the Office of State Construction in counties with
an effective county review process.
- 16 The State Board of Community Colleges shall report the results of its study to the 17 Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee prior to March 30, 2010.
- 18 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
