A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE A 3 SPECIAL PLATE FOR GRADUATES OF THE UNITED STATES SERVICE 4 ACADEMIES, WHICH INCLUDE THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY, 5 THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD ACADEMY, THE UNITED STATES 6 MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMY, THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY, 7 AND THE UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY. 8

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

10 "(b) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be 11 abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued 12 for a commercial vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more, 13 14 must bear the word "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in 15 G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The 16 plate issued for vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word 17 "weighted".

Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division 18 19 for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight" 20 printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate 21 22 shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The following special registration plates do not have to be a 23 "First in Flight" plate. The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be 24 25 approved by the Division and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification. 26

10	service academies may receive a special plate upon furnishing the Division proof of graduation.				
11	The Division must transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate				
12	Account derived from the sale of United States Service Academy plates to NC Support Our				
13	Troops, Inc., to be used to provide support and assistance to the troops and their families."				
14	SECTION 6. This act beco	omes effective J	uly 1, 2009.
