A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE BICYCLES TO HAVE VISIBLE LIGHTS ON THE FRONT AND REAR OF THE BICYCLE WHEN OPERATED AT NIGHT ON A STREET OR HIGHWAY.

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-129(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Lamps on Bicycles. – Every bicycle shall be equipped with a lighted lamp on the front thereof, visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of at least 300 feet in front of such bicycle, and shall also be equipped with a reflex mirror or lamp on the rear, exhibiting a red light visible under like conditions from a distance of at least 200 feet to the rear of such bicycle, when used at night in operation on a street or highway."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
