2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT BICYCLES HAVE VISIBLE LIGHTS ON THE FRONT 3 AND REAR OF THE BICYCLE WHEN OPERATED AT NIGHT ON A STREET, 4 HIGHWAY, OR PUBLIC VEHICULAR AREA. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-129(e) reads as rewritten: 7 Lamps on Bicycles. - Every bicycle shall be equipped with a lighted lamp on the "(e) 8 front thereof, visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of at least 300 feet 9 in front of such bicycle, and shall also be equipped with a reflex mirror or lamp on the rear, exhibiting a red light visible under like conditions from a distance of at least 200 feet to the rear 10

of such bicycle, when used at night.in operation at night on a street, highway, or public vehicular area."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to 14 offenses committed on or after that date.
