A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO RESTORE FUNDING FOR BUDGET ITEMS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF

PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, REVERSING
BUDGET CUTS THAT ADVERSELY IMPACT PROGRAMS PROVIDING SERVICES
TO WOMEN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety the sum of one million four hundred ninety-eight thousand sixty-eight dollars (\$1,498,068) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to restore funding to the following programs in the following amounts:

- (1) Women at Risk \$249,375.
- (2) Summit House \$1,052,756.
- (3) Harriet's House \$195,937.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of five hundred thirty-six thousand four hundred twelve dollars (\$536,412) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to restore full biennial funding to the following programs in the following amounts:

- (1) North Carolina Council for Women \$203,678.
- (2) Displaced Homemakers Program \$30,494.
- 20 (3) Rape Crisis Program \$302,240.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
