2 AN ACT TO ALLOW CERTAIN RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE TEACHERS' AND 3 STATE **EMPLOYEES'** RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND THE LOCAL 4 GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO REMARRIED 5 PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO THE 6 RETIREMENT LAWS TO NOMINATE THEIR NEW SPOUSES TO RECEIVE THE 7 BENEFITS SURVIVOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THAT **TECHNICAL** 8 CORRECTION. 9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

10 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a retired member of the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System or the Local Governmental Employees' 11 12 Retirement System (i) who designated a spouse as survivor under Option 5 as set forth in G.S. 135-5(g) or G.S. 128-27(g), (ii) whose designated spouse predeceased him or her, and (iii) 13 who remarried prior to the enactment of S.L. 2010-72 may nominate the new spouse to receive 14 the survivor retirement benefits in accordance with G.S. 135-5(g) or G.S. 128-27(g), provided 15 that nomination is made within 90 days of the effective date of this act. 16 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 17
