13 14 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-37.16 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(c2) Expiration of H and X Endorsements. – Hazardous materials endorsements shall be renewed every five years or less so that individuals subject to a Transportation Security Administration security screening required pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 383.141 may receive the screening and be authorized to renew the endorsements of H or X to transport hazardous materials. The H and X endorsements on a commercial drivers license shall expire when the commercial drivers license expires."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2011, and applies to endorsements issued for commercial drivers licenses on or after that date.
