The plan shall include costs of, and details regarding, procedures for: 14 Obtaining and maintaining documentation regarding students who (1) 15 successfully complete cardiopulmonary resuscitation instruction in the 16 eighth grade in accordance with the Healthful Living Essential Standards 17 previously adopted by the State Board of Education. SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2012-2013 school year.
