The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 20 of th	e General Statutes is amended by adding
a new section to read:	
"§ 20-137.4B. Mobile phone use in a crash; permissive inference.	
In a civil action for damages resulting from a repo	rtable crash resulting in death or serious
injury, if the trier of fact finds that a mobile phone or	additional technology, as those terms are
defined in G.S. 20-137.3, was in use by a driver at the	time of the reportable crash, the trier of
fact may infer that the use of the mobile phone or addi	tional technology was a proximate cause
of the reportable crash."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective 0	October 1, 2011, and applies to causes of

action arising on or after that date.
