A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE HIGHWAY PATROL TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY
AND COST-EFFECTIVENESS OF HAVING STATE HIGHWAY PATROL UNIFORMS
PRODUCED BY CORRECTION ENTERPRISES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE
LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION'S COMMITTEE ON JUDICIAL
EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Department of Public Safety shall study the feasibility and
cost-effectiveness of having State Highway Patrol uniforms be produced by Correction
Enterprises. The Department of Public Safety shall report the results of this study to the Joint
Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety by March 1, 2015.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2014.
