- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 116-143.6 is repealed.

6 **SECTION 2.** The repeal of G.S. 116-143.6 by Section 1 of this act does not affect 7 the receipt of full scholarships by students who received the scholarships prior to the effective 8 date except as follows: a student's eligibility for in-State tuition provided pursuant to 9 G.S. 116-143.6 is limited to a cumulative total of eight academic semesters.

10 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
