(a) A commodity producer who is certified by the United States Departme Agriculture Agricultural Marketing Service Good Agricultural Practices and Good Han Practices Audit Verification Program shall be entitled to a rebuttable presumption that commodity producer was not negligent when death or injury is proximately caused be consumption of the producer's raw agricultural commodity. This presumption may be over only by clear and convincing evidence.	ndling at the by the
