1 business day after the consumer has received written notification from the insurer that all or 2 any part of the claim or contract is not a covered loss under the insurance policy. 3 (b) Procedure for Cancellation. - Cancellation shall be evidenced by the consumer 4 giving written notice of cancellation to the roofing contractor at the address stated in the 5 contract. Notice of cancellation, if given by mail, is effective upon deposit into the United 6 States mail, postage prepaid, and properly addressed to the roofing contractor. Notice of 7 cancellation need not take a particular form and is sufficient if it indicates, by any form of 8 written expression, the intention of the consumer not to be bound by the contract. 9 Refund of Payments to Consumer. - Within 10 days after a contract for roofing (c) 10 repairs has been cancelled, the roofing contractor shall tender to the consumer any payments, 11 partial payments, or deposits made by the consumer and any note or other evidence of indebtedness. If, however, the roofing contractor has performed any emergency services, 12 13 acknowledged by the consumer in writing to be necessary to prevent damage to the premises. 14 the roofing contractor is entitled to the reasonable value of such services. Any provision in a contract for roofing repairs that in the event of cancellation requires the payment of any fee for 15 16 anything except emergency services shall constitute a violation of G.S. 75-1.1 and shall not be 17 enforceable against any consumer who has cancelled a contract under this section. 18 § 75-146. Roofing contractor's agent for service of process. 19 Every applicant for a roofing contractor's registration who is a nonresident roofing 20 contractor as defined by this act, by signing and filing the application, appoints the Secretary of 21 State as the applicant's true and lawful agent upon whom may be served all lawful process in any action or proceeding against such nonresident roofing contractor for construction projects 22 23 performed in this State. Such appointment in writing is evidence of the nonresident roofing 24 contractor's consent that any such process against the nonresident roofing contractor which is 25 so served upon the Secretary of State shall be of the same legal force and effect as if served 26 upon the nonresident roofing contractor personally within this State. Registered foreign 27 corporations, registered foreign limited liability companies, foreign limited liability 28 partnerships, and foreign limited partnerships entitled to do business in this State and having a 29 current registered agent and registered address on file in the Office of the Secretary of State 30 need not appoint the Secretary of State as agent for service of process under this section. 31 Within 10 days after service of the summons upon the Secretary of State, notice of such service 32 with the summons and complaint in the action shall be sent to the defendant nonresident 33 roofing contractor at the defendant nonresident roofing contractor's last-known address by 34 registered or certified mail with return receipt requested, and proof of such mailing shall be 35 attached to the summons. The Secretary of State shall keep a record of all process served upon 36 the Secretary of State under this section, showing the day and hour of service. Whenever 37 service of process was made under this section, the court, before entering a default judgment or 38 at any stage of the proceeding, may order such continuance as may be necessary to afford the 39 defendant nonresident roofing contractor reasonable opportunity to defend any action pending 40 against the defendant nonresident roofing contractor. 41 "§ 75-147. Application for building permits; disclosure of registration certificate number. 42 Registration Number to Be Noted on Permits. - When applying for any permit (a) 43 required by the State or any of its political subdivisions as a prerequisite to engaging in roofing-related work, a roofing contractor shall supply the permit-issuing official the roofing 44 45 contractor's registration certificate number issued pursuant to Article 1B of Chapter 87 of the General Statutes. That official shall enter a roofing contractor's registration number on the 46 permit. The registrar shall not investigate any roofing project for purposes of verifying roofing 47 48 contractor registration or permit verification. 49 (b)Subcontractor Registration Number to Be Noted on Permits. – A person performing 50 as a roofing contractor on his or her own property, although exempt from the registration 51 requirements of Article 1B of Chapter 87 of the General Statutes, shall, when applying for a

	officials and public.
	Upon request, the registrar shall verify a roofing contractor registration number to city,
	county, and State enforcement officials and to the public. The registrar shall establish through
	the Internet or other technology a verification system or direct access system for confirming
	roofing contractor registration certificates and status of registration maintained pursuant to
	Article 1B of Chapter 87 of the General Statutes. The system shall include the notation of each
	complaint received against an individual roofing contractor, his or her response to each
	complaint by noting whether the roofing contractor admits or denies the allegation, any court
	disposition of a complaint, if known, and any conviction for a violation of the provisions of this
	act. In addition, the system may include a notation for any conviction of a criminal violation in
	this State, another state, or the United States when disclosed by a criminal history records
	search on the individual roofing contractor. Disclosure of any information through use of the
	roofing contractor registration system or information maintained by the registrar shall not be

	fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of application and renewal fees, late fees,
	administrative fees, reinstatement fees, and any other monies collected pursuant to the North

The application and renewal fees shall 4 not be refundable. 5 (b) The Board may determine that a registrant is not in good standing pursuant to 6 violations of this Article or rules adopted by the Board.
