4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-459 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 160A-459. Stormwater control.

7 ...

8 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a city may calculate its stormwater  
9 infrastructure capacity and, where excess capacity exists, may allocate the excess capacity to  
10 urban redevelopment projects. The allocation authorized under this subsection may be used in  
11 lieu of on-site storage requirements. For purposes of this subsection, the term "redevelopment  
12 project" has the same meaning as in G.S. 160A-503(19)."

13 SECTION 2. G.S. 153A-454 reads as rewritten:

14 "§ 153A-454. Stormwater control.

15 ...

16 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a county may calculate its stormwater  
17 infrastructure capacity and, where excess capacity exists, may allocate the excess capacity to  
18 urban redevelopment projects. The allocation authorized under this subsection may be used in  
19 lieu of on-site storage requirements. For purposes of this subsection, the term "redevelopment  
20 project" has the same meaning as in G.S. 160A-503(19)."

21 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
