Judiciary I. Referred to: February 25, 2013 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE VIOLATIONS OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS AND OPEN MEETINGS LAWS A CLASS 3 MISDEMEANOR. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 132-9 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(a1) It is a Class 3 misdemeanor to deny access to public records for purposes of inspection and examination or to deny copies of public records." **SECTION 2.** Article 33C of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 143-318.18A. Violation of Article. Violation of this Article is a Class 3 misdemeanor."

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013.
