## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A DEBTOR TO RETAIN FIREARMS VALUED AT UP TO
3	FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS FREE FROM THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE CLAIMS
4	OF CREDITORS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 1C-1601(a) reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 1C-1601. What property exempt; waiver; exceptions.
8	(a) Exempt property. – Each individual, resident of this State, who is a debtor is entitled
9	to retain free of the enforcement of the claims of creditors:
10	
11	(13) The debtor's aggregate interest in any lawfully possessed firearms, not to
12	exceed a total of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in value. This exemption
13	shall apply to a total of no more than two handguns and four rifles or
14	<u>shotguns.</u> "
15	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2015.
