The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		

6 **SECTION 1.** Article 4 of Chapter 135 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 7 new section to read:

8 "<u>§ 135-75.1B. Forfeiture of retirement benefits for impeachment or removal from office.</u>

9 (a) <u>The Board of Trustees shall not pay any retirement benefits or allowances, except for a</u> 10 return of member contributions plus interest, to any judge who is impeached for reasons other than

11 a physical or mental incapacity interfering with the performance of the judge's duties.

- 12 (b) The Board of Trustees shall not pay any retirement benefits or allowances, except for a
- 13 return of member contributions plus interest, to any judge removed from office under 14 G.S. 7A-376(b)."
