Referred to: Transportation, if favorable, Judiciary IV February 23, 2017 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO STUDY THE DAMAGE CAUSED TO VARIOUS TYPES OF PROPERTIES FROM UNAUTHORIZED USE OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Definition. – For purposes of this act, the term "all-terrain vehicle" has the same meaning as in G.S. 20-4.01. SECTION 2. Study. - The Department of Transportation shall study the impact and damage from the unauthorized use of all-terrain vehicles on State rights-of-way, private property, and farmland. **SECTION 3.** Report. – The Department shall report its findings, including any legislative proposals, to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee no later than December 1, 2017.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. – This act is effective when it becomes law.
