The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
S	<b>ECTION 1.</b> G.S. 14-269.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
" <u>(m)</u> <u>N</u>	lotwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, if educational property is the location of
both a school	l and a building that is a place of religious worship as defined in G.S. 14-54.1, then
person who	has a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance with Article 54B of Chapter 14
of the Gener	ral Statutes or considered valid under G.S. 14-415.24, or is exempt from obtaining
permit pursu	ant to G.S. 14-415.25, may possess and carry a handgun on the premises of the place
of religious	worship and any associated parking lot outside the operating hours of the school."

**SECTION 2.** G.S. 14-415.11(c)(1) reads as rewritten:

Concealed Carry/Church School Prop.

Short Title:

- "(c) Except as provided in G.S. 14-415.27, a permit does not authorize a person to carry a concealed handgun in any of the following:
  - (1) Areas prohibited by G.S. 14-269.2, <del>14 269.3, and 14 277.2.except as allowed under G.S. 14-269.2(m), G.S. 14-269.3, and G.S. 14-277.2."</del>
- **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2017.
