Representatives B. Turner, Ager, and Fisher (Primary Sponsors). Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAYS OF PUBLIC ROADS IN BUNCOMBE COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird with firearm, bow and arrow, crossbow, or other deadly weapon on, from, or across the right-of-way of any State-maintained road or highway, or to discharge any firearm, bow and arrow, crossbow, or other deadly weapon on, from, or across the right-of-way of any State-maintained road or highway. **SECTION 2.** Violation of Section 1 of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor. **SECTION 3.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Buncombe County. **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2017, and applies to acts
