**SESSION LAW 2017-73  
HOUSE BILL 272**

AN ACT TO PERMIT FOX AND COYOTE TRAPPING IN DAVIE AND YADKIN COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for taking foxes by trapping from October 1 through February 28 of each year, with no tagging requirements prior to or after sale.

**SECTION 1.(b)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the open season for taking coyotes by trapping shall be October 1 through March 31 of each year.

**SECTION 2.** No bag limit applies to foxes or coyotes taken under this act.

**SECTION 3.** The Wildlife Resources Commission shall provide for the sale of foxes and coyotes taken lawfully pursuant to this act.

**SECTION 4.** This act applies only to the Counties of Davie and Yadkin.

**SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
