A person who hunts on Sunday in a manner prohibited under subsection (a) of this (b) section or rules adopted by the Wildlife Resources Commission shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor. Provided, that the provisions of this section are not applicable to military reservations, the jurisdiction of which is exclusively in the federal government, to field trials authorized by the Wildlife Resources Commission, or to actions taken in defense of a person's property. Wildlife protectors are granted authority to enforce the provisions of this section."

**SECTION 2.** Section 5(c) of S.L. 2015-144 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 5.(c) Subsection (b) of this section becomes effective October 1, 2017. 2020. A county may adopt an ordinance to prohibit Sunday hunting prior to October 1, 2017, 2020, but any such ordinance shall not become effective until October 1, <del>2017.</del> 2020. The remainder of this section becomes effective October 1, 2015."

**SECTION 3.** The Wildlife Resources Commission shall complete a study that includes, but is not limited to, examining biological and resource management impacts, economic impacts, and social impacts associated with hunting migratory birds on Sunday. The Wildlife Resources Commission shall submit its findings to the Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the chair or chairs of the House Committee on Wildlife Resources no later than March 1, 2018.

**SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
