SECTION 1. It is unlawful to discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, or to attempt to		
discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way of		
any public road. For purposes of this section, the term "public road" shall not include any unpaved		
roads within the Wildlife Resources Commission's Sandhills Game Land.		
S	EECTION 2. Violation of the provisions of this act is punisha	ble as a Class 3
misdemeano	r.	
S	ECTION 3. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officer	s of the Wildlife
Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general		
subject matter jurisdiction.		
SECTION 4. This act applies only to Richmond County.		
S	SECTION 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 2017, and approximately 100 per 1, 20	pplies to offenses
