## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE VETERANS' AFFAIRS COMMISSION TO ADOPT A 3 COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGIC PLAN TO ENHANCE BENEFITS FOR VETERANS 4 AND THEIR DEPENDENTS AND TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY 5 AND VETERANS AFFAIRS TO STUDY PROGRAM OUTCOMES FOR MILITARY 6 VETERANS AND THEIR FAMILIES. 7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 8 **SECTION 1.** Article 14 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is amended by
- 9 adding a new section to read:

## "§ 143B-1221.1. Strategic plan. 10

Strategic Plan. - The Veterans' Affairs Commission shall adopt a comprehensive 11 (a) strategic plan to enhance benefits for veterans and their dependents. The strategic plan shall 12 include specific objectives related to the following topics: 13 14

- Improving accessibility of health, education, training, counseling, financial, (1)and burial benefits and services to veterans and their dependents.
- Increasing the satisfaction of veterans and their dependents with benefits and 16 (2)17 services by meeting their expectations for availability, quality, timeliness, and responsiveness. 18 19
  - Educating and empowering veterans and their dependents through proactive (3) outreach and effective advocacy.
  - Any other topic related to enhancing benefits for veterans and their (4)dependents.

23 Update, Review, and Report. - The Commission shall update this plan every four (b) 24 years. The Commission shall annually review the State's performance based on this plan and 25 shall annually report the results of its review to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on General Government." 26

27 **SECTION 2.** The Veterans' Affairs Commission shall adopt a strategic plan by 28 November 1, 2018. The Veterans' Affairs Commission shall complete its first annual review 29 and its first annual report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on General Government 30 by November 1, 2019. The Veterans' Affairs Commission shall complete its first update of the 31 strategic plan by November 1, 2022.

32 SECTION 3. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs shall study 33 potential methods for documenting, collecting, and analyzing the outcomes for individual military veterans and their families in this State of the various programs designed to serve them 34 and shall report its findings and recommendation to the chairs of the Senate and House of 35



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- 1 Representatives appropriations subcommittees on general government no later than December 1, 2017.
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- **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
