43A of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes." G.S. 105-468.1 is an administrative provision that applies to this Article. A tax levied under this Article does not apply to the sales price of food that is exempt from tax pursuant to G.S. 105-164.13B or to the sales price of a bundled transaction taxable pursuant to G.S. 105-467(a)(5a). The Secretary shall not divide the amount allocated to a county between the county and the municipalities within the county.

"<u>§ 105-513.4. Use.</u>

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A county may use the proceeds of a tax levied under this Article only for public school capital outlay purposes, as defined in G.S. 115C-426(f), and to retire any indebtedness incurred by the county for these purposes."

SECTION 2. Part 1 of Article 43 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 105-506.3. Limitation on levy.

A tax levied under this Article may not be in effect in a county at the same time as a tax levied by that county under Article 43A of this Chapter."

SECTION 3. G.S. 105-164.3(4a) reads as rewritten:

- "(4a) Combined general rate. The sum of all of the following:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>The State's general rate of tax set in G.S. 105-164.4(a) plus the G.S. 105-164.4(a).</u>
 - b. The sum of the rates of the local sales and use taxes authorized <u>for every county in this State</u> by <u>Subchapter VIII</u> Article 39 of this Chapter or Chapter 1096 of the 1967 Session Laws, Article 40 of this Chapter, and Article 42 of this <u>Chapter for every county in this State.</u> Chapter.
 - <u>c.</u> One-half of the maximum rate of tax authorized by Article 46 of this Chapter."
- 25 **SECTION 4.** This act applies to Cabarrus County only.
- **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
