2	AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THAT ECONOMIC NEXUS IS THE BASIS FOR COLLECTION
3	OF SALES TAX BY REMOTE SELLERS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-164.8(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
6	"(b) Remote Sales. – A retailer who makes a remote sale is engaged in business in this State
7	and is subject to the tax levied under this Article if at least one of the following conditions is met:
8	•••
9	(9) The retailer, with respect to remote sales into North Carolina for the previous
10	calendar year, had one or more of the following:
11	a. Gross sales in excess of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
12	b. Two hundred or more separate transactions."
13	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2017, and applies to sales made on or
14	after that date.
